

### Marine and Naval Duty Motors

Our committed team of R&D engineers is successful in developing special duty motors for marine applications. These motors comply with Indian Naval Standards. Production facilities at LHP have already been approved by DGQA for supply to the Indian Navy. These motors will successfully meet the challenging requirements of the Indian Navy and shipyards for sea-worthy performance. The specifications are as per EED-Q-071 R3 and the present range includes motors up to 315kW and the frame sizes are from 63 to 355L. These motors are tested and approved by authorised test labs approved by the Indian Navy. LHP Marine and Naval Duty motors are

designed and manufactured at our world-class plant in Solapur.

Rugged die-cast Aluminum rotors are precision-balanced. All tests are conducted in our in-house state-of-the-art test facilities, results documented, controlled and declared in the test certificates that are being issued with each and every motor. LHP Marine and Naval duty motors are designed and engineered for continuous reliable performance and easy maintenance.

Typical applications include Compressors, AHUs (Air Handling Units), Blowers anchoring and other marine & naval applications.


